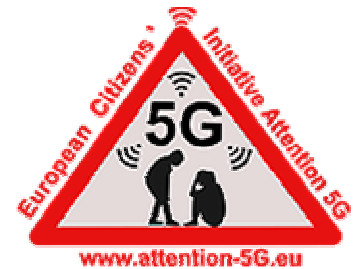


Dear Supporters of
a low-radiation living environment



Thank you for your interest in the topic of mobile radio radiation and our European citizens' initiative "**Attention 5G**" – in short: EBI "Attention 5G". In the future we will inform you about various actions in the context of 5G. But first of all we would like to introduce our European initiative to you in this letter.

The 5G Bundestag petition published in March/April 2019 with almost 55,000 signatures made clear that 5G is a topic that moves citizens. Now we want to change the European legal framework with a Europe-wide movement, in order to minimize the pollution of the environment with mobile radio radiation and the associated risks and dangers as good as possible. We are in favour of technological innovation, but not at any price. **Health must always be the highest priority.**

Today, the European Union sets the pace for the EU Member States, including the European regulatory framework for mobile communications. Only together can we create so much political pressure to change the regulatory framework Europe-wide so that mobile radio radiation or alternatives are used in a way that does not harm anyone. This is what our main demands are based on, primarily to the EU Commission.

1. Our goals to protect the health of citizens and their liberty rights in Europe are:

- 1.1- Europe-wide regulation of the applications of 5G mobile communications technologies in the following fields: inviolability of life and limb, data protection, energy production (climate change), immunity of the home.
- 1.2- Harmonisation of the legal framework for applications of 5G mobile communications technology in the European Member States, in particular for uniform and consistent application of the European precautionary principle within the EU Member States.
- 1.3- Recognition of electrosensitivity as a disease in Europe.

2. Our goals in detail, which also lie in the sovereign responsibility of the individual EU member states:

- 2.1 - Application of the precautionary principle to potential risks of mobile communications, based on sufficient scientific knowledge.

2.2 - Application of the requirement to minimise identifiable harmful effects of mobile communication.

2.3 - Review of new reference or limit values for the maximum exposure of all radio wave systems, i.e. all wireless communications (including non-ionising mobile radiation and its athermal effects). This review should be carried out by independent experts (without links to commercial companies or political interests) and environmental associations.

2.4 - A Technology Assessment and a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) for all areas affected by 5G: Health (physiological and psychogenic effects), biosphere, militarisation 4.0, power consumption, informational self-determination of citizens (monitoring, data protection), effects on democratic decision-making and decision-making processes.

2.5 - Minority protection for people suffering from electrosensitivity or electrohypersensitivity (EHS). This includes the recognition of EHS as a disease, a general ban on the exposure of electromagnetic fields on private property, the establishment of workplaces for the disabled, the realisation of so-called "white" zones in public areas as well as in local and long-distance public transportation facilities.

2.6 - Establishment of new radiation guidelines or limits for the maximum exposure of all radio wave systems, i.e. all wireless communication (including non-ionising mobile radiation and its athermal effects).

2.7 - Expansion of wired digital telecommunications.

2.8 – Adoption of an EU Commission recommendation for an 'immediate moratorium' on the expansion and commissioning of 5G in all EU Member States until potential risks to human health and the environment have been fully researched, free from any financial involvement of industry, but also free from economic policy interests and expectations of the state.

2.9 - Research on the risks of mobile radio technologies by independent research institutions, which can carry out their studies and research on electromagnetic radiation, in particular in connection with the development of 5G, free from any financial participation of industry, but also free from economic interests and expectations of the state.

2.10 - More financial resources should be made available for research into the risks and hazards of mobile communications technologies, in particular with a view to

revising the Council Recommendation of 12 July 1999 on the limitation of exposure of the general public to electromagnetic fields and Directive 1999/519/EC and Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2018 on the European Electronic Communications Code (Directive (EU) 2018/1972) and the European Electronic Communications Code Directive.

In the near future, we - as EBI "Attention 5G" - will provide the infrastructure for a supra-regional, digital network. We finance the enormous financial expenses, for example for the programming of the voting software, printed material, graphic artists, web designers, expert opinions, procedural costs, exclusively from donations. We are dependent on your support and the support of a broad civil society, in order to be able to prevent ubiquitous radiation in our living environment and also to be able to realize effective activities in all social areas of society.

This concerns, on the one hand, the mobile communications that we already have (GSM, UTMS, LTE, TETRA, Wi-Fi ... etc.) and, on the other hand, the broad and deep effects of 5G technologies.

The 5G expansion, worth billions of euros, is to begin as early as next year. Therefore, we must not wait until 5G technology is introduced and the harmful effects are realized!

Parallel to the institutionalized forms of citizen participation "Bundestag petition" and "EBI", we see the chance to counter the harmful effects of mobile radio with effective legal steps. Lawyers are invited to follow this path with us, since now - with the socio-technical system 5G in all its facets - a legal precedent is likely to exist.
